About North Guwahati:

North Guwahati is situated on the northern bank of the river Brahmaputra just opposite to the city of Guwahati. This ancient capital town of ancient rulers of Kamrup also enjoy the privilege of being the birth place of some erudite scholars of Assam like Anundoram Barooah, Karmabeer Nabin Chandra Bordoloi, Bolinarayan Borah, Col. Sivaram Borah, Lakshiram Baruah, and many others. It is known as one of the temple town of Assam with important sites of pilgrimage such as Ashwagranta Dewalaya, Dirgheswari Dewalaya, Manikarneswar Dewalaya, Rudewswar Dewalaya, Doul Govinda Mandir, Auniati Satra etc.

About North Gauhati College:

North Gauhati College established in 1962, was the lone institute of higher education for a long time catering to the need of the students of a vast area on the North Bank of the Brahmaputra covering places like Hajo, Sipajhar, Changsari and Baihata Chariali. The college has at present both Arts and Science streams with major courses. The college also offer different courses in distance mode under KKHOU and skill education under UGC B. Vocational course.

The college has been accredited by NAAC with Grade B in 2016.

About the Department of Anthropology:

The department of Anthropology, North Gauhati college was started in the year 1972. Since inception the department has been shining with bright academic achievements. In 1999 the department produced the Best Graduate in Arts of Gauhati University and in 2002 one of the student secured highest mark in Anthropology in HS Examination.

How to reach:

The college is well connected to the city of Guwahati (Fancy Bazar Ghat) by Ferries of Inland Water Transport Department and private motor boats. It is only 12 km distance from Jalukbari via Amingaon and 3 km distance from Gouripur (National Highway No- 31). Tempos are available in both Gouripur and Jalukbari to reach the college.

About the Seminar:

The Constitution of India guarantees to all Indian women equality (Article 14), no discrimination by the State (Article 15(1)), equality of opportunity (Article 16), and equal pay for equal work (Article 39(d)). In addition, it allows special provisions to be made by the State in favour of women and children (Article 15(3)), renounces practices derogatory to the dignity of women (Article 51 (A) (e)), and also allows for provisions to be made by the State for securing just and humane conditions of work and for maternity relief. (Article 42).

However, the women in India are subjected to atrocities such as domestic violence, rape, molestation, dowry harassment, wife battering, trafficking, sexual harassment at work places, acid throwing etc. Crime against women is an over increasing problem in India which has been growing more acute in recent years.

The North East India is a remote part of the with its diversity in ethnicity, language, culture, society etc. The women of this region are enjoying limited facilities in all spheres. So the main objective of this seminar is to discuss about the present status of the women of North East India with special reference to the following sub themes.
